Albion EDC To Host Annual Economic Forecast

Albion, MI, February 12, 2021: The community is invited to join the Albion Economic Development Corporation (AEDC) for the 2021 Albion Economic Forecast, Thursday, March 4th, at 5:00 p.m. This annual informational event includes updates on local economic and community development efforts from the previous calendar year and an overview of where the Albion, regional, state, and national economies are likely headed in the next several years.

The program will feature a presentation by AEDC President & CEO, Amy Deprez, including status updates on various development projects happening in Albion and the planned solar farms in Sheridan Township.
